PRO BONO PROGRAMS IN MICHIGAN

LSC - LEGAL AID AGENCIES FOR LOW INCOME INDIVIDUALS

These are often thought of as the basic legal services or "legal aid" offices, and are sometimes referred to as field programs by planners. Most every program has more than one office in their territory. Priorities and abilities to serve the public vary by program. Almost all listed here must concentrate on serving only the very poor (within 125 percent of poverty or less - with a few exceptions such as service to a senior citizen). Each has its own intake procedure and potential clients must go through that screening or intake process - which is often done initially by a simple telephone call.

These programs have agreed to make sure that they or someone in their service region provides basic information, at least, to eligible clients in the areas of domestic violence/family law, public benefits, and housing related issues. Some offer help in other fields of law as well. These programs are discussing merger possibilities and may reconfigure. We try to keep this list updated but cannot guarantee accuracy. This list was last revised in April 2003.
